**Ian Landles**

Was the swimming pool still in existence or was that just at the First World War.

**Reene Currie**

Eh, I think by that time it had been wrecked, more or less. It was a purpose built pool that.

**Ian Landles**

You can still see a wee bit of the grab rail. It's still there for... at one end. [Pause].

**Andrew Jepson**

That was just for the soldiers though, not for... you didn't go in there did you?

**Reene Currie**

[Laughs]. On the fly. [Laughter]. I remember once being in a dreadful panic because I had pulled, oh it was a metal rod, I had... I haven't a clue what it was but I'd pulled it and let all the water out of the pool. An' I was in a panic about it.
