There was one thing that you mentioned about using munitions for egg cups.

Walter Oliver

Ah, yeah, we used to pick up, there was a little black Bakelite thing off the end of one of the bombs and we used to get them for egg cups. We used to use them for egg cups. It was just a little black thing like, half of Hawick had them, they were the same, and eh, they used to come off when they fired them, this little cover over the end. And people used to pick them up and, eh, the parachutes we used to use for handkerchiefs, you know, they were silk, made with silk.
