Ian Landles

And then your family were involved with the construction of the cemetery?

Walter Oliver

No, I think the cemetery was... oh, one of ma uncles used to cart the stones for them. I think it was Uncle Tom, I remember ma Dad saying something about Uncle Tom and his brother. He was killed in the war, Tom, his name's on the thing. But I think it was him, he used to take a couple of Germans down in the horse and cart down to, down to Woodfoot. They used to pick out the stones that they wanted 'cause there was a lot of these big flat round things at Woodfoot, on the river bed on the way up. They used to select what they wanted and throw them in the cart and he used to take them up.
